Esther Flitcroft would be the Charity Committee Chair and her committee members are Ginger Woltosz, Debbie Reesman, Flavin Glover, Cindy Reinke, Linda Fenty, Karen Hughes, and Doretha Smith. All board members present (including by proxy) were in favor of the committee.

Esther procured a day from the Chamber of Commerce to be a dedicated sew day for the Israel charity quilts. She was given the option of January 13th or 20th. She will poll the guild members at the November guild meeting. In addition, she will have sign-up sheets for members to bring soup, bread, and desserts. All trash has to be taken out after the event.

Esther will address the guild with information about the current status of the charity quilts at the November Guild Meeting. She will give a demonstration on

how to quilt these quilts on a domestic machine. In addition, she will inform the guild on the best way to join scrap batting.

Cathy Browne will bring the preprinted CBQG quilt labels to attach to the charity quilts.

Michelle recommended for a "Plan B" to be in place in the event that the quilts do not make it to Israel. Chamber of Commerce would need to be informed of any changes to the destination of the charity quilts.

Michelle stated that she was very pleased with the guild participation to date.
