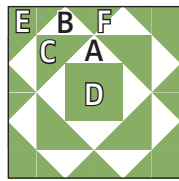

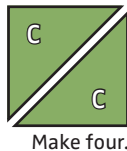
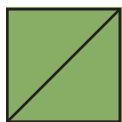
### Cutting:

Background	A 2 - 1 5/8" squares	2 - 2 3/8" squares	2 - 3" squares
	B 8 - 1" x 1 1/2" rectangles	8 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles	8 - 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles
Print	C 2 - 2" squares	2 - 3" squares	2 - 4" squares
	D 1 - 1 1/2" square	1 - 2 1/2" square	1 - 3 1/2" square
	E 4 - 1" squares	4 - 1 1/2" squares	4 - 2" squares
	F 16 - 1" squares	16 - 1 1/2" squares	16 - 2" squares

Use 1/4" seams and press open throughout.  
Sizes listed as (3" size) [6" size] {9" size}

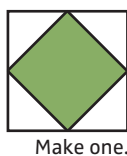
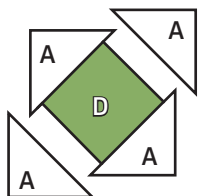
### Block Assembly:

Cut the Fabric A squares and Fabric C squares on the diagonal once.



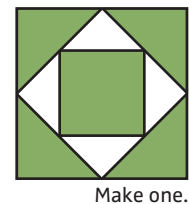
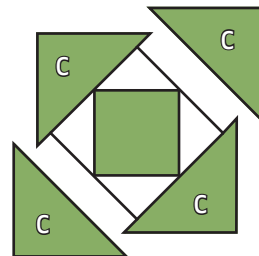
Assemble four Fabric A triangles and the Fabric D square.

Trim Partial Center Unit to measure  
(2" x 2") [3 1/2" x 3 1/2"] {4 3/4" x 4 3/4"}.



Assemble four Fabric C triangles and the Partial Center Unit.

Trim Center Unit to measure  
(2 1/2" x 2 1/2") [4 1/2" x 4 1/2"] {6 1/2" x 6 1/2"}.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F squares.  
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on one end of a  
Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

Repeat on the opposite end.

Flying Geese Unit should measure  
(1" x 1 1/2") [1 1/2" x 2 1/2"] {2" x 3 1/2"}.



Assemble two Fabric E squares and two Flying Geese Units.

Outer Unit should measure

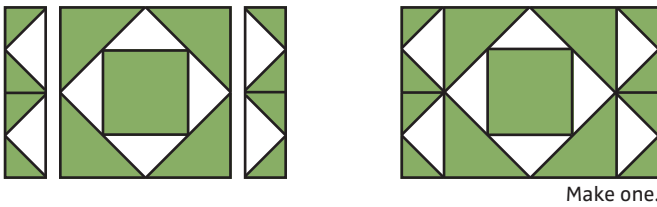
(1" x 3 1/2") [1 1/2" x 6 1/2"] {2" x 9 1/2"}.



Assemble four Flying Geese Units and the Center Unit.

Inner Unit should measure

(2 1/2" x 3 1/2") [4 1/2" x 6 1/2"] {6 1/2" x 9 1/2"}.



Assemble Block.

Unity Block should measure

(3 1/2" x 3 1/2") [6 1/2" x 6 1/2"] {9 1/2" x 9 1/2"}.
