Each person is to make four 9.5" blocks with the fabric and be ready to swap them in July. Participants need to create something with the blocks and be ready to present to guild in November.

At the February guild meeting, members played a "**Fabric Strip Game**." Those that had won strips were to create something to show at March guild meeting.
