

BOARD MEETING MINUTES

COTTON BOLL QUILT GUILD

October 9, 2025

Present: Cathy Browne, Pat Hobaugh, Michelle Kloeti, Irene Bushnell, Rebekah Crawford, Kamie Loomis, and Emily Hill.

5:27 pm Board Meeting called to order by Rebekah Crawford.

Rebekah asked for a motion to accept the **July Board Meeting Minutes**. Pat Hobaugh moved to accept the minutes and Cathy Browne seconded the motion. All board members accepted the minutes.

Next board meeting will be held on **Dec. 4th at 5:00 pm** via zoom. This will be right before the Christmas Party.

Board Member Nominees - Rebekah announced that Linda Hayes presented the names of the nominated 2026 Guild Board Members.

Rebekah asked for a motion from the executive board to accept the candidates. Pat Hobaugh moved to accept the candidates and Michelle Kloeti seconded the motion. The nominees are running unopposed. The slated candidates will be presented to the guild members for the election at the October guild meeting.

Executive board appointed the committee chairpersons. Social Media Chair – Emily Hill, Program Committee Chair – Cathy Browne, and Retreat Committee Chair – Michelle Kloeti. Kamie Loomis moved to accept the committee chairpersons and Pat Hobaugh seconded the motion. All board members were in favor.

Rebekah Crawford has reached out to the **Chamber of Commerce to secure next year's meeting dates**. She has not received a reply as of yet. The Chamber has not set up the 2026 calendar year. Rebekah asked if there were any exceptions to the "normal dates." The retreat is from May 14th-17th, so it will not interfere with the meeting date of May 21. Cathy Browne reminded board

members about the March 2026 program. Brenda Rickett will be presenting the Laura Heine collage quilt technique on Thursday, March 19th, and will have a workshop on the following Friday, March 20th.

Emily and Cathy discussed the need for a new cord for the guild camera.

Cathy reported that the program committee has a rough idea of programs thru October 2026. Rebekah inquired about the need for a contract for the March speaker. Cathy will follow up with presenter.

Retreat - Michelle Kloeti addressed the board with possible retreat plans for next year. The participants will need to commit by December 2025 if Charlie Elliott will be procured. A minimum of 25 members need to attend. Michelle has reached out to other groups to buffer the attendance numbers. There is a QOV group from Coweta and some ladies from Carrolton who are interested in joining us. Michelle has broken down the cost using 22 participants. If more than 22 attend, refunds will be issued.
